

RUSSIAN JEWS TO FLEE TO U.S.

Secretary of Immigrant Aid Society Says Thousands Will Need Assistance on Arrival.

TO MAKE ADDRESS IN DULUTH SYNAGOGUE

**Regardless of War's Result, Jews
Will Be Losers, Dr. Kornblith Says.**

Funds for the relief of thousands of Jews, who, he says, will be driven to this country as a result of the European war will be collected in Duluth by Dr. R. Kornblith of New York, district secretary of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid society of America.

Dr. Kornblith, who arrived here yesterday, will speak at services this morning in Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street. Tomorrow night he will address a mass meeting in the synagogue.

Duluthians Directors.

Included in the list of directors of the aid society are the following Duluthians: Commissioner B. Silberstein, Rabbi Maurice Lefkovits, Ben Blumenthal, Nathan Kris, S. Rine, D. J. Segal and P. Sher.

Dr. Kornblith said that regardless of the outcome of the European war, the Jews will be the losers and the greatest sufferers. "When a Jewish soldier in the Russian army falls in battle," he said, "his family loses its residence. Most of these will have to come to the congested cities here and it is the aim of our society to help them.

80,000 Jews Driven Out.

"Eighty thousand Jews have been driven penniless from Warsaw since the outbreak of the war. These people are coming to this country and we should assist them in becoming good citizens. There are 350,000 Jews fighting in the armies of Russia.

"Through intense anti-semitic feeling in Russia our people are being driven from the most important cities. Their only haven is the United States."

Dr. Kornblith said that in the Twin Cities more than \$1,500 was subscribed toward the relief work. His subject at the mass meeting will be "The War and Its Results." Rabbi I. Teplitz of Adas Israel synagogue, also will speak. S. Karon, president of the congregation, will preside.
