

CHARGED WITH BUYING STOLEN BOILER PARTS

Ferrules and bushings, valued at more than \$150, which disappeared from the plant of the Northwestern Boiler works at 315 Banks avenue, are alleged by the police to have been purchased by S. Karon, a local junk dealer, who was arraigned in municipal court yesterday on a charge of receiving stolen property. The case was adjourned until July 14. Karon was released on \$300 bail.

The brass taken from the boiler works consisted of 600 ferrules, each worth 7 cents, and about 126 bushings, valued at 95 cents apiece. The total value of the property is \$161.70.
