Leon Zolotkov, Noted Yiddish
Writer of New York, to Speak
in Duluth August 19.

Leon Zolotkov, New York, one of America's most noted Yiddish journalists, will speak on "The Present Problem of the Jews in the Warring Countries," Aug. 19, at 8 p. m., at Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street.

Zolotkov, who is past grand master of the Order of Knights of Zion, is touring the United States under auspices of the organization for purposes of creating sentiment for calling at an early date a Jewish international congress for purposes of solving Jewish problems, not only in the European war zone but all over the world.
