

HERE TO ENLIST JEWS IN WAR FOR RIGHTS

Leon Zolotkov, Yiddish Editor,
to Talk Tonight of Problems of
Race in Warring Nations.

Leon Zolotkov, New York, Yiddish novelist and journalist, will speak on "The Present Problem of the Jews in the Warring Countries," tonight at 8 p. m. at Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street.

While in Duluth, Mr. Zolotkov will endeavor to effect a permanent organization which shall at a date in the near future take part in a great congress of Jews to be held in the United States for purposes of solving world problems of the Jewish peoples.

It is expected Mr. Zolotkov will pass at least two days here.

In discussing the object of the speaker's visit, A. Mogelson, member of the local arrangements committee, last night said:

"Every Jew must clearly remember this—and accordingly exercise his political influence, that if the Jews of Russia do not get their rights at once, while the war lasts, or at least a publicly guaranteed promise to get the same after the war is over, they will never get equal rights in Russia.

"Jews all over the world, the free Jews of England and France, and especially the Jews of the United States must organize at once and create a tremendous movement of freedom and exercise all their influence to gain at once political freedom for the Jews in Russia."
