

ROSH HASHANAH RITES END; YOM KIPPUR NEXT

Orthodox Jewish observance of Rosh Hashanah, New Year's, came to a close last night at sundown after a two-day period of prayer. Services were conducted in Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street.

Day of Atonement or Yom Kippur services will be conducted all day next Saturday. The celebration will begin next Friday night at sundown when all orthodox Jews will abstain from food for 24 hours.
