

OLD COPIES OF HIGH SCHOOL ANNUAL BRING \$30 AT RUMMAGE SALE

At a "rummage" sale at Central high school yesterday, old copies of the Zenith 300 were sold by the 1916 Zenith board for 10 cents a copy.
