

TODAY TAG DAY FOR JEWS IN WAR ZONE

Collections for Sufferers to Be
Solicited Under Auspices of
Relief Committee.

Today will be "tag day" in Duluth for the Jewish war sufferers in Europe. Facts tending to show there are more than 2,000,000 destitute Jews in the present war zone, including Galicia, Courland, and Poland, were brought out at a meeting of the Du-

luth branch of the Jewish War Relief committee at the Hebrew institute, when final arrangements were made for "tag day."

In three provinces some of the heaviest battles have been waged, and as a result, practically all of the residents, mostly Jews, are now without food or shelter. It also is reported that many of those driven out by the Russian soldiers are wandering about on country roads.

Last Friday evening at the Yom Kippur services at the Temple Emanuel, Dr. Maurice Lefkowitz obtained subscriptions from the members, amounting to \$1,100. In addition to this amount, Rabbi I. Teplitz of the Adas Israel synagogue has collected \$300, while other workers have obtained \$100.
