

SUGGEST GIVING PAGEANT AGAIN

Industrial School Head Favors
Fourth Presentation if Spon-
sored by Civic Organization.

ASK ANOTHER STAGING
Scenes Depicting History and
Growth of Superior Re-
quire Cast of 179.

Although there have been demands from many quarters for another presentation of the historical pageant, "Superior," given three times last week by industrial school pupils, P. B. Clemens, head of the all-day industrial school stated yesterday that no other performance would be given unless sponsored by some civic organization.

The pageant depicted in three scenes many of the traditions, legends and historical incidents connected with the site of the city of Superior and its civic growth.

The first scene showed an Indian settlement with the wigwam of Buckanda, a Chippewa chief whose tribe was supposed to occupy the present site of Superior in the foreground. The arrival of the first whites, including French fur traders and Father Allouez, the Jesuit priest, was pictured.

The second scene showed the interior of Superior home on New Year's eve, at the time of the Civil war. The speaking parts brought in allusions to the early history of the city and its pioneer characters.

The third scene was in the form of a tableau in which the coming of the arts, industries, and the nationalities to Superior was shown.

The spirit of Superior appeared in each of the scenes, first as a child, then as a maiden, and finally as a mature woman.

More than 1,200 persons attended the three presentations given in the Matt Carpenter building.
