

OTHERS MAY ENTER RACE AT VIRGINIA

**Two Expected to File for Mayor.
Eight Lined Up for Al-
derman-at-Large.**

VIRGINIA, Jan. 22.—William Rooney, George Shea and Andrew Grande have been mentioned as candidates for mayor. Michael Boylan, the present mayor, and W. H. Eaton are the only candidates thus far. Grande declares he will not enter the race, but Rooney and Shea are non-committal.

Charles W. Lundström has filed as a candidate for alderman-at-large, making the eighth to enter the race. Lundström was a member of the council until the summer of 1914, when he resigned and was succeeded by A. D. Heritage. He was president of the council.

Adolph Kellar, a well known horse dealer, is another of the candidates for alderman-at-large. Kellar was defeated by J. L. Kimball in a recall election held in Virginia in 1912. Later Kimball resigned and Kellar was appointed to serve out his unexpired term of a few months.

Aldermen A. D. Heritage, Dan Coffey and R. J. McGhee, Charles Olson, William Eddy and William Tritchler are the other candidates for the council. The election will be held Feb. 8. Only a few days remain for filing.

It is not expected that there will be developments at the eleventh hour in the judgeship race.
