

JEWISH RELIEF FUND EXCEEDS ESTIMATE

**Eastern Mesaba Residents Con-
tribute Liberally to Aid Eu-
ropean War Sufferers.**

VIRGINIA, Jan. 27.—The Jewish Relief fund campaign in Virginia, Eveleth and on the eastern Mesaba will exceed by more than \$2,000, the original estimates of committees. At a meeting at Eveleth last night the Jewish people subscribed nearly \$400. Sam Siegel, treasurer of the Eveleth committee, stated that he expects the total will reach \$1,000.

The work was not concluded to-night, as had been expected, because of the blizzard, but will be continued until tomorrow noon, to allow further time for committeemen to visit the business men.

The officers of the Eveleth committee are: President, Sam Ellis; treasurer, Samuel Siegel; secretary, Harry Levant.

The Virginia committee: Max Lewis, president; Sam Milavetz, vice president; Julius Shanedling, treasurer; finance committee, Morris Shanedling, Ben Milavetz, Sam Lippman, Rueten Latz; publicity committee, M. K. Baer, Ralph Wilk, Nathan Kellar.

Treasurer Shanedling tonight reported that more than \$900 had been collected in Virginia and that a large number of people had not been visited. The Virginia committee solicited funds in Aurora and Biwabik. J. Johnson raised \$125.

The Eveleth committee is soliciting in the Genoa location and in the village of Gilbert. The entire eastern Mesaba has been divided into small districts and Virginia and Eveleth men given authority to collect in each place.

The collections will be turned in to a general fund at a meeting to be held tomorrow night and then will be forwarded to the Jewish Relief fund headquarters.
