

SAYS WIFE IS CAUSE OF HIS INSOLVENCY

Jacob Sher Files Answer to Di- vorce Complaint Brought by Spouse.

In answer to allegation advanced by his wife, Sarah Sher in a suit for divorce, Jacob Sher filed an affidavit in the district court clerk's office yesterday alleging that his wife threatened to poison him with Paris green, continually nagged him about his business losses, and was the cause of his becoming insolvent. Sher alleged that "his life was endangered in other ways" than by the poison route.

In the complaint Mrs. Sher filed, she claims that her husband required her to remain in a cheap boarding house in Two Harbors that was inhabited by several negroes. The case will be heard by District Judge Dancer during the November term of court.

Judge Dancer granted the plaintiff temporary alimony of \$5 a month and \$25 for attorney fees yesterday morning.
