

# STORE FIRE STARTED BY PLUMBER'S TORCH

The clothing store of Samuel Guinn, 113 East Superior street, was gutted by fire yesterday morning, starting, it is said, from a blow torch left by a plumber near frozen water pipes. The loss, principally by water and smoke, was covered by insurance.

The flames spread to the living rooms upstairs, occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Guinn, and furniture and a piano were damaged. According to Guinn, he called a plumber to thaw out the pipes and the mechanic left the flaring torch too near the wall.
