

## DULUTH GIRL MAID OF HONOR AT WEDDING OF COUSIN IN EAU CLAIRE



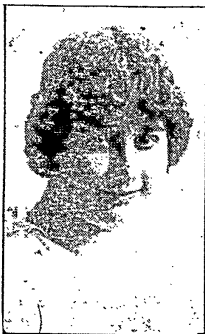
