

HEBREW LECTURER TO SPEAK IN SUPERIOR

Problems of Jewish People Will
Be Discussed—Will Talk
in Yiddish.

Dr. Benzion Mossinsohn, well-known Jewish lecturer from Palestine, will be the principal speaker tonight in the Hebrew synagogue, Hammond avenue and North Sixth street. The subject of his talk will be "Grave Problems of Today of the Jewish People." Although his talk will be in Yiddish, he will tell of the efforts being made to bring about a general revival of the use of the Hebrew language among the Jewish people. The lecture will begin promptly at 8 o'clock.

Dr. Mossinsohn will arrive in Superior this afternoon from the Twin Cities. A large delegation of Jews will meet him at the depot. He will be the guest of honor at a banquet to be held at the home of Elias Siegel, 1610 Hughitt avenue.
