

HIBBING WINNER OF MEET AT VIRGINIA

**Proves Superiority on the Cin-
ders—But Two Points
Margin.**

VIRGINIA, June 3.—On a muddy field the Hibbing track team won from Virginia in a hard-fought battle for the range title by two points this afternoon in the first intercity track meet ever held on the range. Jess Porteus of Hibbing was the star of the meet, securing the highest number of points for this time, while William O'Rourke of Virginia was second.

The points scored by the teams entered follow: Hibbing, 56; Virginia, 54; Chisholm, 9; Coleraine, 4, and Elwabik, 3. The relay race, the big event of the day, was won by the Virginia team. No very good records could be made today because of the heavy field.
