

JEWES OF DULUTH TO EXPAND PLANS FOR CIVIC CENTER

Young Folks League Will Or- ganize Tonight; New York Rabbi to Speak.

Organization of a Young Folks' league for the Duluth Jewish center will take place tonight at a mass meeting of Jewish young men and women of the city in the auditorium of the Hebrew institute at 310 and 312 East Third street. Dr. Benjamin Plotkin of New York city, visiting rabbi in Duluth, will speak. A musical program also has been arranged.

The pressing need of the local Jewish community for a Jewish community center has been pointed out by Dr. Plotkin, who is advocating the center as a home for all Jewish activities of this city—educational, religious, charitable and social.

Jewish community center activities have already begun. The Sunday School Teachers' Training school, organized recently by Dr. Plotkin, will begin its intensive study course Monday night, Sept. 20, at 8 o'clock. Tuition is free. The course will consist of a series of lectures on Jewish history, religion, modern Jewish problems and kindred subjects. Young men and women may register at the Hebrew institute Monday night.

A Jewish Music league is organizing, and will be one of the Jewish community center activities. Anyone interested in the organization, whether vocal, instrumental or study, is asked to communicate with Miss Anna Las-kawitz, 327 East Fourth street. The first meeting of the Music league will take place Monday night at 8:30 at the institute.
