

'INFIDELITY' OF JEWS IS DENIED

Duluthians Flay Cohn's Statement That Hebrews
Worship Christ.

"WAS PAID TO SAY IT"

Rabbi Lefkovits and Commissioner Silberstein Stirred
by Bold Assertion.

Duluth Jews yesterday denounced assertions by Joseph Cohn in the tabernacle at West Duluth Monday night, when he declared "Jews in the United States are secretly worshipping Christ, fearing prosecution should they do so publicly."

"Of all races, the Jews have been the most faithful in their religion, kept their belief from outside influences, in spite of fearful prosecution, that all know," said Rabbi Israel Tepplitz, of Adas Israel congregation. "If such statements were made by Joseph Cohn, he is not a representative of the Hebrew race. He cares more for the gold that he gets for making such statements than he does for his race," added the rabbi.

Rabbi Maurice Lefkovits of Temple Emanuel said he did not care to dignify the matter by discussing it.

"The Cohn statement is ridiculous," said Public Safety Commissioner Silberstein. "It is not only untrue, but not elevating to either religion."

"The speaker would not even make a good Christian," curtly remarked Charles D. Oreckovsky, prominent in B'nai B'rith affairs.
