

DISCARDED CIGAR STUBS CAUSE HIBBING FIRE

HIBBING, Jan. 6.—Fire which was discovered at 3 o'clock this morning in the home of Harry Gram, a cigar maker, on Garfield street, drove the family outdoors in their night clothes. After a hard fight of two hours, the flames were prevented from reaching beyond the upper story, where the blaze originated.

Gram has a cigar factory in the upper story of the residence and was there about midnight, he said. Stubs of cigars thrown on the floor are believed to have caused the fire. The damage amounted close to \$100.
