

FIGHT ON OCT. 19 IS CALLED OFF

Tommy Gibbons and George
Chip to Battle Here on Nov.
2—Great Card Arranged.

The fight between Johnny Ritchie and Johnny Ertle, two bantam-weights, scheduled at Duluth auditorium for Oct. 19 has been called off, according to a telegram received by Secretary Stein of Zenith Athletic club. Curley Ulrich, who was promoting the bout, declared in the telegram that George Chip and Tommy Gibbons will fight here instead on Nov. 2.

The remainder of the card will be the same as that of the Ertle-Ritchie one. Harry Littman will meet "Kid" Alpert in a six-round opener. Both are fast boys and a good bout is expected. Steve Hopkins, the colored football star of St. Paul, will meet Darrell Smith in the second bout of the evening, which will go 10 rounds. The semi-windup has not been arranged as yet, although it is expected that Billy Whelan will meet some fast local lightweight.
