

DULUTH MAN REPORTS BIG BUY OF LAND FOR HEBREW HOME

Charles D. Oreckowsky returned yesterday from Chicago, where he attended a meeting of the general committee of district No. 6, Independent Order of B'nai B'rith. Mr. Oreckowsky states that the meeting was called primarily to ratify the purchase by the Cleveland orphan asylum of 170 acres of land for \$73,000. The land, known as "Cherry Farms," will be used as sites for new cottages for wards of the orphanage. The main orphanage at Cleveland has 500 rooms and the land upon which it stands was purchased in 1868.
