

# SIX-MILLION ESTATE HAS FINAL SETTLEMENT MADE

Final accounting of the administrators of the estate of the late Chester A. Congdon was admitted to probate before Judge S. W. Gilpin yesterday. All accounts against the estate have been allowed and the distribution of shares in accordance with the will made to the heirs. This completes the settlement of one of the largest estates ever admitted to probate in Duluth, with a total valuation of over \$6,000,000.

Inheritance taxes to be paid by the estate of the late Lazarus Rubenstein, who died at Gilbert, Dec. 16, 1916, was determined in probate court yesterday. The estate had a total valuation of \$76,580.29 and inheritance tax was paid on \$16,195.03, the sum of \$217.92 being paid County Treasurer Vivian. The widow, Sarah Rubenstein, and five children, are named as heirs.
