

WOULD EXTEND SCOPE OF OLD FOLKS' HOME

Rev. W. Kissin, superintendent of the Jewish Home for the Aged at St. Paul, is in Duluth for the purpose of creating an interest to extend the activity of the home to the northwest. Rev. Mr. Kissin, will speak at the Adas Israel synagogue, Third avenue East and Third street, this morning. He will explain the movement and assist in organizing a Duluth branch among Jews.

The institution has housed only aged persons in St. Paul and has been in existence 10 years.

Rev. Mr. Kissin is making a tour of Minnesota, Wisconsin, the Dakotas and Iowa to interest Jews in the new plan.
