

CHILDREN IN AUTOS; PARENTS IN LAW SUIT

VIRGINIA, Feb. 6.—Samuel Cohen filed a complaint in district court today asking \$1,000 damages from Julius Shanedling as the result of an automobile accident in which neither was directly involved.

In the complaint Cohen alleges that Aug. 24, 1916, his daughter, Anna Cohen, a minor, was injured in the Shanedling car, which was operated by Monroe Shanedling, minor son of Julius Shanedling.

Young Shanedling is said to have invited Anna Cohen for a ride from Virginia to Cedar Island lake, along with other young people. The automobile was overloaded, it is alleged by Cohen, and ran in a ditch.

In the accident, Anna, is asserted to have suffered bruises and cuts about the knee, arms, face and head. A scar over her eye, Mr. Cohen declares, will disfigure her for life.
