

SOPHOMORES WINNERS IN ANNUAL MEET

Seniors, Juniors and Freshmen
Finish in Order—Winners
Cop Relay.

MAURICE KARON STARS

Captain Merritt Also Figures in
Victory of Sophs—J. Anderson
Lone Freshie in Meet.

Led by the fighting spirit of their captain, Merritt, the sophomores of Duluth Central high school yesterday carried off all honors at the annual track meet between the classes of the institution.

The teams finished in the following order: Sophomore, 42; seniors, 29; juniors, 21 and freshmen 11.

Merritt and Karon of the victors were by far the stars of the meet. The former scored 15 points for his class while his teammate made 13 points. J. Anderson, the only entry the freshmen had in the meet, scored 11 points, winning one first and two seconds.

Just before the 440-yard dash a fight between two grade school pupils started. Several minutes were lost recalling several of the entrants in the event who had gone off to see the fight. All the spectators also deserted the track to see the fight.

Dashes Most Interesting.

The dashes were the most interesting events of the whole meet. Karon starred in both dashes.

After winning the 100-yard dash in a heart-breaking finish Karon re-entered in the 220-yard dash.

From the start the race was one that would take the heart out of any runner. Of the six entrants only three passed the tape.

Karon led at 150-yard line with Hardgraves, representing the junior class, a close second. Neck to neck the boys raced to the tape and at each step they drew further away from their opponents. With but 10 yards to go the pace began telling on Karon and Hardgraves gained on him. The two crossed the tape with Hardgraves leading by inches. Karon collapsed after crossing the tape.
