

# BABIES CAUSE LAW SUIT

## ONE SHOT IN EYE IN PLAY

---

**VIRGINIA, May 2.**—Alleging that Simon, 4-year-old son of Solomon Sax, shot out the left eye of Margaret, 2½-year-old daughter of Wilbert F. McDonald, all of Eveleth, action to recover \$8,000 damages was begun today in district court by Mr. McDonald.

It is set forth in the complaint that Jan. 28, 1912, the two children were playing together in the hall of the Grant building at Eveleth, when Simon fired a toy gun at Margaret, a dart piercing her left eyeball.

As a result, it is claimed, the child became blind in this eye and her face disfigured. Since the mishap glasses have been provided the child, but in spite of this she became cross-eyed, according to Mr. McDonald.
