

JEWES WILL ELECT CONGRESS CANDIDATES

Two Nominations Will Be Made
May 13 at Talmud Torah
Auditorium.

A nominating convention to elect two candidates for representatives to the American Jewish congress from the district comprising the state of Minnesota exclusive of the cities of St. Paul and Minneapolis, will be held Sunday, May 13, at 3 o'clock at the Talmud Torah auditorium, Duluth.

The two candidates nominated will be voted on at large at the general election to be held June 10, 1917. The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast at the general election will be the representative of this district at the Jewish congress which will convene Sept. 2, 1917, at Washington, D. C.

Every organization is requested to hold a meeting of its members for the purpose of electing one delegate to the nominating convention.
