

RUSSIAN TROOPS SENT TO PEREYASLAV

Petrograd, June 8.—The complete autonomy of Pereyaslav district of little Russia has been declared by M. Krustaleff-Nosar, who was president of the executive committee of the workmen's council during the revolution of 1905. It was also reported that he refused to send soldiers any supplies from the district. Representatives of the council of soldiers and sailors and a detachment of troops have been sent to Pereyaslav.
