

TINY GIRL DECLARES WOODEN DART WILL HANDICAP MR. CUPID

VIRGINIA, Sept. 13.—Claiming that his client's matrimonial chances will be impaired, although she is but 7 years old, Attorney J. J. Giblin today urged a jury to return a verdict in favor of Margaret McDonald, who, through her father, Wilber F. McDonald, is suing to recover \$8,000 from Solomon Sax.

When Margaret was two years old she suffered an injury to the left eye. Her attorney contends that a wooden dart shot by Simon Sax, four years old, son of Solomon Sax, was the cause.

The eye is slightly turned. For this reason, Attorney Giblin declared, the young men will slight her in the years to come. Solomon Sax was declared negligent because, it is claimed, he provided the toy gun with which the eye was injured.

A sealed verdict was returned by the jury and it will be opened Monday by Judge Edward Freeman, who presided over the trial. All parties to the action reside in Eveleth.
