

JEWS PLAN CLUBHOUSE; BUILDING TO COST \$15,000

Officers and Committee Are Elected to Conduct Campaign for Funds.

At a meeting of the congregation of the Adas Israel synagogue last night in the vestry final arrangements for the erection of a clubhouse for the Jewish people of Duluth, were completed. The amount decided upon for this building was \$15,000 and is to contain a gymnasium, club-rooms, and all the necessary features to care for a large membership.
