

WHOLE-HEARTED SUPPORT GIVEN RED CROSS FUND

HIBBING, June 11.—This community's Red Cross quota has been oversubscribed by 50 per cent, as a result of the war fund committee donating \$30,000 to this work, at a meeting held at headquarters today. The quota set was \$20,000. The amount voted includes all contributions from the mining companies and other subscribers. The Jewish petition for an amount to be donated to the Jewish relief fund was referred to the committee on investigation. E. S. Tillinghast, Charles Hallock, and Con Keppel.

Over \$8,000 is the grand total from Hibbing and vicinity, to be paid monthly into the war fund for war purposes. This amount has been raised in two weeks' time. The sum of \$5,382 was paid by the employes of mining companies, 5,382 in number, while \$2,043 was paid by 1,357 subscribers in Hibbing proper.

In addition to the war fund, \$12,738 has been donated by mining companies and other concerns for war purposes, and \$264 by individuals.
