

# DECISION PLACES NAMES ON BALLOT AT QUEEN CITY

## Attorney General Orders That Mayoralty Candidates of Vir- ginia Be Voted On Jan. 22.

---

VIRGINIA, Jan. 17.—Attorney General Lyndon A. Smith has ruled that the names of Mayor Michael Boylan and Edward C. A. Johnson, mayoralty candidates, must go on the primary election ballot, and be voted on, Jan. 22, according to advices received today. They both will survive the primary and will be on the ballot again at the regular election on Feb. 5.

### Believed Unnecessary.

It was at first believed that neither Boylan or Johnson would campaign before the primary, as it was not thought their names would appear on the ballot.

Voters will get the satisfaction of seeing a test of the strength of the respective mayoralty seekers. The result Jan. 22, is expected to indicate just about how the final decision will be.

Today was the last day for withdrawal and only one candidate, Ben Milavetz asked that his name be taken off the prospective ballot. He was a candidate from the third ward for alderman.
