

LOUIS PRESS OF VIRGINIA REPORTED KILLED IN ACTION

VIRGINIA, Oct. 9.—Louis Press of Virginia, a cousin to the Shanedling brothers and former employe of their store, has been killed in France, according to an official statement received today.

Press was 25 years old and had resided in Virginia for about 10 years prior to entering the service of his country. He left here in September, 1917, and received his military training at Camp Dodge. He had been in France about three months.
