

FILE PETITIONS IN PROBATE COURT

Special Administration Asked for Estate of Sam Lippman. Other Applications Made.

Special administration of the estate of Sam Lippman who died at Virginia, Jan. 24 last, was asked yesterday in papers filed in probate court. The widow asks appointment as special administratrix. The estate is valued at \$42,000, which includes \$20,000 stock in the Minnesota Dry Goods company as well as real estate in the region of Virginia. Besides the widow, four daughters and two sons are named as heirs in the petition for special administration.

Petition for administration was also filed in the estate of Frank Snyder, who died Jan. 17, last. Josephine Snyder, widow, asks the appointment of administrator. The estate is valued at \$1500 and besides the widow, three sons and a daughter are named in the petition.

Susan Brooke Estate.

Susan A. Brooke, who died at Jackson, Mo., Jan. 27, last, left an estate in St. Louis county valued at \$2,000. A son, John Brooke, and a daughter Mrs. Gladys Smith, are named as heirs in the petition for administration in which the daughter asks the appointment as administratrix.

Contest for the right to administer the estate of the late Martin Smith, who died last summer was filed in probate court yesterday and will be argued before Judge of Probate S. W. Gilpin, some time this week.

Application was not made for administration by the heirs, within the required time and a creditor made application for the probating of the estate. The widow then applied, and opposing claims must now be presented to the court.
