

KONKEL'S ANNOUNCEMENT TO THE VOTERS OF SUPERIOR

I want to call attention to some of the things we have done during the last six years. We settled the street ends case, making more than \$125,000 for the city. We appealed the Belknap viaduct case, won out in supreme court and saved \$15,000 of the city's money. We have paved twenty miles of streets, laid sixty miles of concrete walks and built twenty-five miles of sewers. We have installed 235 new street lamps, at an additional cost to the city of only \$2,556 a year. We have built two magnificent new school buildings and purchased the site for a new ward school. We have purchased two new parks, added two blocks of land to Central Park and greatly improved the other parks. We have turnpiked a vast number of streets, making them passable at all seasons of the year. We have built toboggan slides for the children, thus encouraging winter sports. We have torn out all the old wooden bridges and replaced them with modern concrete culverts. We have been motorizing the fire department just as rapidly as possible.



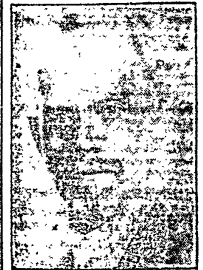
Some Things For the Future.
Here are a few things that I have in mind for the near future: To double the size of Billings Park, in order to accommodate the crowds that congregate there. An artificial bathing beach, to be kept open from April to November. A big indoor and outdoor skating rink, free to the public. Toboggan slides for all the parks, to encourage winter sports. The immediate improvement of the new Fifth Ward park. Better fire protection for the South End, to take care of the growing industries in that part of the city. To pave Tower avenue from Twenty-eighth street to Fifty-eighth street—this to be done next year if war conditions will permit. We have just let a contract to pave Lombard avenue and Main street to the Interstate bridge. That work will be done as soon as the weather permits. We are also going to pave Central avenue southwesterly to the city limits, and Cadotte avenue from West Fifth street to the new orphanage. That makes up the bulk of the paving program for this year. It isn't our intention to do any more public work during the war than is absolutely necessary. Sidewalks will, of course, be built where the old wooden walks are in a dangerous condition. We have also let a contract for a concrete bridge over the Pokegama river on Central avenue. The primary will be held next Tuesday and it is your duty to vote. Every man should vote for what he believes to be his own best interests. I appreciate past favors more than I am able to express in words, and I most earnestly solicit the suffrage of all who think I am deserving.

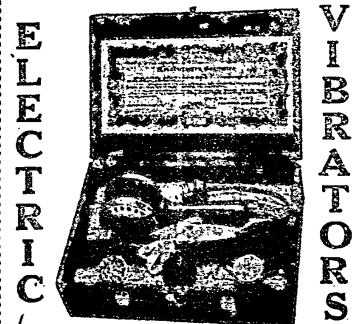
