

Virginia Sleuths Find Fancy Wines With Suit Stock

VIRGINIA, April 22.—An unusual assortment of liquors for supposedly dry territory, and one particularly startling for an alleged blind pig, is exhibited by the police as a result of their raid on a Virginia establishment.

Arraigned today before Municipal Judge James P. Carey, the defendant, Ben Walt, charged with liquor selling was bound over for trial in district court. Bail of \$250 was furnished.

The police allege finding the following liquors in a search made of the store premises: Whiskey, brandy, benedictine, port wine, wintergreen, California rye, Reisling wine, Hiawatha bitters, Sloe gin, Italian wine, creme de minthe, gin, claret, etc.
