

GIRL STRUCK BY AUTO

SUSTAINS MINOR HURTS

Hazel Bradley, 19, received minor injuries last night when she was struck by a machine alleged to have been driven by Bert Karon of Superior. The accident occurred at Sixth avenue West and First street. Miss Bradley was crossing the street with a friend, Edward Mayrand, 904 North First avenue East. Louis Handlovsky, 618 Banks avenue, Superior, was a passenger in the machine. Miss Bradley was taken to St. Luke's hospital in the police emergency.

Miss Cecilla Marcotte, injured Wednesday night by an automobile at Lake avenue and Superior street, was in an improved condition, hospital authorities stated last night. Following the accident she was in a serious condition, due to a nervous shock.

Joseph Zoey, driver of the machine which struck Miss Marcotte, pleaded not guilty in municipal court yesterday and was released on \$100 bail pending trial. Karon was brought to police headquarters and charged with reckless driving. He was latter released on \$25 bail.
