

CHISHOLM CLAIMS FIRST; HAS \$6,000 FOR JEWISH RELIEF

CHISHOLM, June 11.—Chisholm leads the towns on the range so far in the amount subscribed to the Jewish Relief fund. The total up to tonight was over \$6,000.

"How do you do it?" is what Leo Sapero of Minneapolis, secretary for the state association, telegraphed Simon Sapero, chairman of the local branch, sending congratulations on the result. "Even Minneapolis does not come up to Chisholm in comparison to the population."

The sum of \$1,500 to be paid in six months by payments beginning July 4 was subscribed by the United States Defense league of Chisholm. Aside from this \$5,200 has been raised in Chisholm, Buhl, and Kinney. Forty-four persons in Chisholm proper subscribed \$3,500. At Buhl P. J. and M. A. Mecalis sub-

scribed \$100 each and Walter Manson and Sam Rabalski subscribed \$50 each. At Kinney \$300 was raised. Here M. Ladian subscribed \$120, and M. Minkin \$100, besides numerous smaller sums.

"We expect more for this fund, as there are still a number of persons to be heard from, and everyone is a patriot in Chisholm," said Chairman Sapero today.
