

SIX RECRUITING OFFICERS HERE GET PROMOTIONS

Since August, 1917, six members of the local army recruiting party have received promotions while on duty at the local office. Sergt. James A. Sheeran, head of the Duluth office, who was commissined an officer in the reserve engineer corps and who left last Friday to take up his new duties, was the sixth man to receive a commission while a member of the Duluth party.

Four of the six promoted held the rank of sergeant up to the time of promotion; one was a corporal and the other a private. All of them were transferred to the reserves and sent to reserve officers' training camps. Three of them, Sergt. Howard R. Huston, Sergt. Edward McDermott and Corp. Olaf Berlie were North Dakota university men who joined the army and were assigned to recruiting duty. The other men who received commissions are: Sergt. Samuel Wiener and Private Paul Short.
