

WAR WORKER'S GRAIN BURNED; PRO-GERMANISM INTIMATED

RICE LAKE, Wis., Sept. 8.—Fire of unknown origin destroyed 13 large stacks of grain on the Harry Widde farm, three miles from this city.

Mr. Widde, who is a Duluth stock buyer and operates a large farm near here, has been actively engaged in Red Cross and other war work, to which he has made large donations. It has been intimated that the burning of the grain was instigated by some one opposed to his activities.
