Sixteen aliens were naturalized at a citizenship hearing before Judge Page Morris in United States district court yesterday. Six of the men who received final papers were Russians, three Norwegians three Swedes, two Englishmen, one Dane, and one Luxemburger. One applicant was refused citizenship because of the fact that he had claimed exemption from military service on the ground of being an alien.
