

Louis Gomberg Home; Famous Teacher Dies

Louis Gomberg, Duluth's prodigy and one of the most gifted pupils of the late Richard Epstein, has returned to his home in the city. The young artist, who was given his first instructions at the age of 4, is now 12 years old.

The late Mrs. D. H. Day, who taught Louis the fundamentals of piano playing, intended to take him east to study under Epstein two years ago. However her death prevented her from carrying out the plan and hearing of her intentions, Epstein wrote to the parents of the boy, offering his services as a teacher of the young pianist. The proposal was accepted and Louis went east and began a course of lessons with Epstein.

In June shortly after Epstein was taken ill, Louis left for Duluth to spend his vacation.
