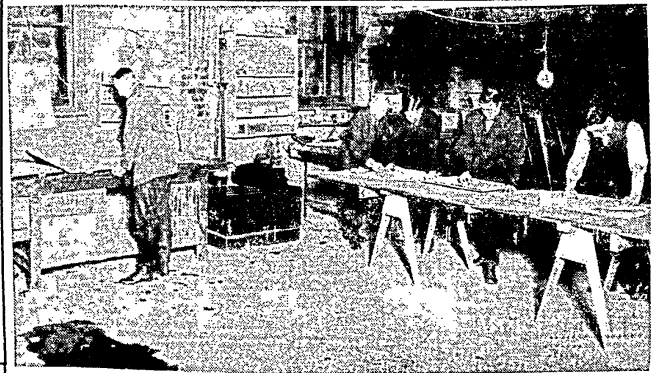


# ARTISTS, ARTISANS 'MADE' AT SCHOOLS
