

STATE PLAINTIFF IN 18 SUPERIOR LIQUOR ACTIONS

Judge Parker May Call Judge French to Hear Some of the Cases Today.

Eighteen state cases charging violations of the liquor laws are dated for hearing in municipal court at Superior today before Judge F. S. Parker. Judge J. B. French may be called in to hear some of the cases. The following have been notified to appear for trial: Robert Delahunt, F. Feeney, Henry Kolanek, Max Rosenberg, Chet Bell, D. J. Ryan, G. M. Smith, Charles Olson, James Guyott, William Frymiller, John Anderson, Joe Dawson, Paul Gappa, Gus Beck, John Stralho, Pat McDermott, H. Benedict and John Stemedes.

Three state cases and one brought by the city, all involving liquor charges, were called yesterday. Arnold Milavitz and Abe Solosky were adjudged not guilty. The cases against Leo Leamons, Charles Hooper and Stewart McCutcheon were ordered adjourned until Thursday at 10 a. m. Upon motion of T. L. McIntosh, assistant corporation counsel, the case of the city against John Burke was dismissed.
