

# COURT ATTACHES HUNT CORRIDORS FOR LONE JUROR

## 15 Were Passed by Court But Three Were Minors, One Was Deaf and One Missing.

Bailiffs and court attaches functioning as "bell hops" failed to find one stray grand juror in courtrooms, corridors or offices of the courthouse yesterday morning. As a result, the jury session was delayed until the afternoon. When Judge W. A. Cant called the roll 15 jurors answered to their names, but when the sixteenth name was called there was no answer. The law provides that 16 grand jurors are needed to constitute a quorum before the body can go into its star chamber session.

### Three Were Minors.

When the venire was called three of the men selected were found to be minors, one was not a citizen of the United States, one was afflicted with deafness and another had been excused by the court, and the "missing sixteenth" had misjudged the time the grand jury was to be called and for that reason failed to appear until the afternoon roll call.

The grand jury will not complete its session until this afternoon. There are 14 more criminal cases to be disposed of before the final report is made.

Out of 287 jury cases placed on the calendar for the November term, 252 will be tried. Judge W. A. Cant, who has charge of the term continued 17 cases and struck 16 from the calendar.
