

TROPHY OWNERSHIP IS SETTLED; ANOTHER SOUGHT

By winning two of the three debates Friday night, one with Denfeld high school and the other with Superior Central, Duluth Central high school asserted their permanent ownership of the Garon trophy cup. "Candidates" for the honor of giving a new trophy are now being sought.

The cup was presented in 1917 by the Garon Jewelry company, to be debated for by the Denfeld, Superior Central and Duluth Central high schools. In order to become owner of the cup, a school had to win it twice. Duluth Central succeeded in winning first, in 1917, while Superior Central won the following year. Because of this, a victory this year by either Superior or Duluth Central was to decide the possessor. Had Denfeld won against Central all three schools would have had an equal chance next year.
