

# CHARGE 'RABBI' STOLE \$10,300

## Alleged Companion, Chisholmite, Arrested During Services in Chicago Synagogue.

---

CHICAGO, Sept. 26.—Services in a west side Jewish synagogue were interrupted today when detectives arrested Solomon Rubloff on a charge of being implicated in a \$10,300 robbery at Chisholm, Minn.

Rubloff is said to have introduced a "fainting" rabbi named Green, who switched envelopes while water was being brought for his "recovery." Green is still at large.

CHISHOLM, Sept. 26.—Rubloff is well known here. He removed from Chisholm three years ago but still has property in the village.

His alleged victim was Louis Roth, a merchant and custodian of a fund for the relief of Jews in Russia.

The "rabbi" alleged to have been introduced by Rubloff visited the Roth store, where the money was kept in an envelope in a safe. Mrs Roth was alone. The "rabbi" fainted. While Mrs. Roth hurried away for water, the switch in envelopes is said to have been made, the "rabbi" substituting one in which only blank paper was later found.

Roth kept quiet for several days after making his discovery, then went to his bank for aid. The bank called in the Burns detective agency. The "rabbi" is still at large. Rubloff is said to have been with him often.
