You will oblige me very much if you print this little article in your paper. In a communication by a Duluth Central student (N. B.) in your Sunday morning edition I noticed that the T. H. S. S. gymnasium was described as "hole in the school." Poor little boy, N. B.
Listen to this N. B.: The high school gym floor at Two Harbors is one of the finest basket ball floors in the state. The length between side bounds is 87 feet, width between end bounds is 47 feet. Now my dear child, if a player desired to take a shot from one end of the floor to the basket at the other end he could do so very easily without fear of hitting the ceiling. It might also be well to state that the distance between the floor and ceiling is absolutely free from girders or any thing else which would in any way interfere with the ball if it happened to go up that high. I will admit, however, that the one basket which is supported by poles could be suspended from the ceiling but to a real basket ball player (not a knocker) this makes very little if any difference.
Some of the best teams in northern Minnesota and Wisconsin have played

on this floor in the past four years and this same floor which you describe as a "hole in the school" was actually praised by these teams.
