Parcel Post Weights—The weight limit is now 50 pounds in the local, first and second zones, or 150 miles from the starting point, and 20 pounds in all other zones. Ordinary postage stamps may be used on all packages. Postage Required—The pound rates in the first and second zones, a distance from Duluth of 150 miles, will be:
