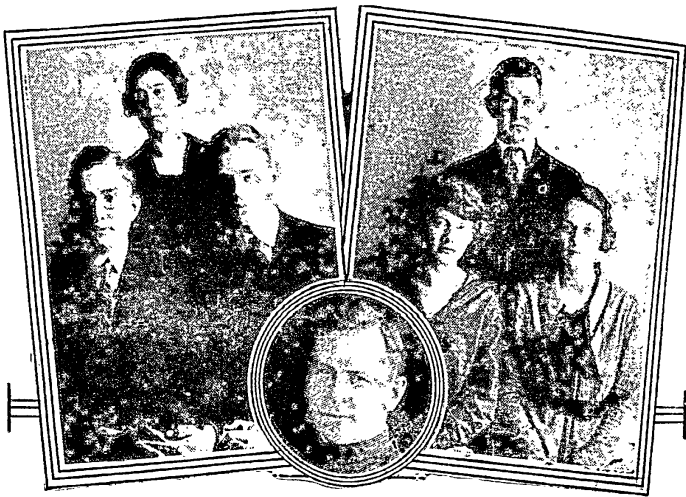


DENFELD STUDENTS PREPARE FOR DEBATES
