

# STREET RAILWAY COMPANY WINS IN TWO JURY CASES

The Duluth Street Railway company was victor in two damage suits totaling \$7,200 in district court yesterday. Both were jury trials in which verdicts were returned against the respective plaintiffs, Josephine Campbell and Sarah Oreckovsky.

A jury in Judge Bert Fesler's division held that the defendant could not be held responsible for the death of Kenneth Campbell, age 10, alleged to have been killed by a motor truck owned by the street railway company. The plaintiff was Josephine Campbell, administrator of the boy's estate.

Sarah Oreckovsky sued for damages of \$2,200, alleging that she was injured as she was alighting from a street car, but a jury in Judge W. A. Cant's courtroom brought in a verdict for the street railway company.
